

WITH WHOM?

A project led by several associations and collectives of the territory — Cévennes 2050, Fruits Oubliés et biodiversité en Cévennes and Terres Vivantes en Cévennes — gathered within the Cerise association for this project. With the support of a network of partners involved in the social and solidarity economy.

FOR WHOM?

Everyone! An open resource place, where you can come to learn and train, for individuals as well as professionals. With special attention to young people and to those affected by food and energy insecurity.

HOW?

- Give farmers access to land
- Renovate housing for farmers and project holders,
- Provide reception spaces,
- Create shared spaces and workshops,
- Develop training and accessible tools around self-sufficiency.
- Sustain a collegial governance to guarantee a lasting, shared place.

WHERE?

At the CAMBON farm, by the Gardon river in Mialet (30). A typical Cévenol farm with 14 ha of terraces and forest, springs, basins and a building of over 300 m².
